Purple Picnic activity ideas

Add a splash of purple, a sprinkle of fun, and a generous heart – every activity helps raise funds to provide Buddy Bags and support for children who need it most.



Classic picnic games with a twist

Add a \$2 entry fee and a small prize for the winner.

- **Egg and spoon race** – It's a classic for a reason. Bonus: wear purple while racing!
- **Balloon waddle** – Hold a purple balloon between your knees and waddle to the finish.
- **Three-legged race** – Pair up and tie legs together for a dash to the finish.



Scavenger hunt

Create a short list of things to find around the park, garden or office. Set a timer and collect a gold coin to enter. First one to find everything wins a prize!



Workplace trivia

Include fun questions like: "Guess who wanted to be a pop star when they grew up?" Ask for donations to play and offer a small prize for the winning team.



Bake-off

Invite guests to bring a baked treat inspired by their favourite childhood recipe. Ask for a donation to enter or taste-test!

Simple fundraising boosters

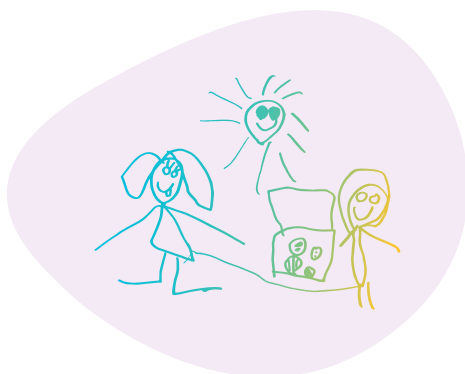


Donate to participate
